All Registered Diagnostic Medical Sonographer's may help with guiding/supervising medical staff in LOU training. This role will assist the Lead Sonographer to ensure maintenance of ultrasound machinery. This role ensures that all services are implemented in agreement with the mission, philosophy and policies and procedures of the organization. This person will be equipped and participate in the client advocacy role as well as Sonographer role.

## Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Responsible for making sure that professional, competent and compassionate care according to all policy, protocol and procedures is provided for all clients.
- Complies with state and professional licensing and continuing education requirements.
- RDMS Sonographers will be responsible to help with training/supervising medical staff who have completed LOU training until approved to scan independently.
- Assists and communicates with the Lead Sonographer with: medical supply inventory; maintenance issues of ultrasound equipment; cleaning/infection control procedures; and the archive of client files from all ultrasound machines.
- Assures all regulatory, legislative, and medical accuracy in all ultrasound services.
- Attends bimonthly medical staff meetings, periodic all staff meetings and in-services.
- Works in conjunction with other Medical Personnel and Center Volunteers to assure clients are receiving the best medical, educational and psychosocial care possible.
- Knowledgeable of and skilled in use of highly technical sonography equipment.
- Provides accurate documentation of all necessary client forms in a timely manner per protocol and adheres to all Medical Director standing orders.
